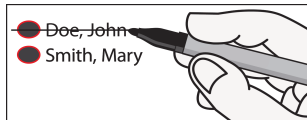
**INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS:**

If you make an error on your selection, make a strikethrough across the oval and name or answer indicating your intent NOT to vote for that selection.

**Optional Write-in**



To vote for a qualified write-in candidate, write the person's name in the blank space provided and FILL IN THE OVAL to the left.

**WARNING:** Any person who, by use of force or other means, unduly influences an eligible elector to vote in any particular manner or to refrain from voting, or who falsely makes, alters, forges or counterfeits any mail ballot before or after it has been cast, or who destroys, defaces, mutilates, or tampers with a ballot is subject, upon conviction, to imprisonment, or to a fine, or both. Legg</p>	<p><b>Ballot Measures</b></p> <p>Ballot questions referred by the general assembly or any political subdivision are listed by letter, and ballot questions initiated by the people are listed numerically. A ballot question listed as an "amendment" proposes a change to the Colorado constitution, and a ballot question listed as a "proposition" proposes a change to the Colorado Revised Statutes. SHALL CHEYENNE COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. RE-5 DEBT BE INCREASED \$2 MILLION, WITH A REPAYMENT COST OF UP TO \$ 3,209,700 MILLION, AND SHALL DISTRICT TAXES BE INCREASED BY UP TO \$ 179,882 ANNUALLY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING, REPAIRING AND IMPROVING THE DISTRICT'S EXISTING FACILITIES TO EXTEND THEIR USEFUL LIFE, TO THE EXTENT ANY SUCH REPAIRS ARE NOT OTHERWISE COVERED BY INSURANCE, BY THE ISSUANCE AND PAYMENT OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS WHICH SHALL BEAR INTEREST, MATURE, BE SUBJECT TO REDEMPTION AND BE ISSUED AT SUCH TIME, AT SUCH PRICE (AT, ABOVE OR BELOW PAR) AND IN SUCH MANNER AND CONTAINING SUCH TERMS, NOT INCONSISTENT WITH THIS BALLOT ISSUE, AS THE BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY DETERMINE; AND SHALL AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAXES BE LEVIED WITHOUT LIMIT AS TO A MILL RATE CONSISTENT WITH THE COST PARAMETERS SET FORTH ABOVE AND IN AN AMOUNT SUFFICIENT IN EACH YEAR TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SUCH DEBT AND TO FUND ANY RESERVES FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF?
